

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order (1) creating a proposed of the N/2 S/2 of Section 15. Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Yeso formation underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Pilum 15 Fee No. 1H Well, which will be nonzontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 16 to a standard bottom hole location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 15. The completed interval for this well will remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by the rules. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation designation of COG Operating LLC as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well.
