
Outcomes

No Makeup Water

Continue East Hobbs San Andres Waterflood as is:

- · Production declines from present rate of 162 BOPD
- · Economic limit is reached in April 2019
- · Field is abandoned



Makeup Water

Initiate New CO₂ Flood East Hobbs San Andres:

- · In late 2015 begin water fill up and monitor progress quarterly
- In late 2017 stop all makeup water and begin CO2 injection
- · Peak oil will be reached in 2020
- · An incremental 4.6 million barrels of oil will be recovered
- · City of Hobbs receives 3300 feet of new water main
- · City of Hobbs receives an estimated \$1,000,000 revenue for water
- Royalty owners will be paid an estimated \$55,000,000 *
- Severance and Ad Valorem Taxes estimated at \$11,300,000 *
- · Sales tax on local goods and services purchased
- · Field life will be extended 13 to 15 years
- · Potential for further CO2 development, extending the Field life

* Assuming \$70/bbl. oil
