APPLICATION

EOG Resources, Inc. ("EOG") files this application for an order approving the Bridge State Unit. In support of this application, EOG states:

1. The proposed Unit Area for the Bridge State Unit consists of approximately 3,520 acres of State lands in Lea County, New Mexico, comprised of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST

Section 16: S/2  
Section 20: W/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4, W/2, SE/4  
Section 21: All  
Section 22: E/2, SW/4  
Section 27: N/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4, NW/4, SE/4  
Section 28: N/2, SW/4, W/2 SE/4  
Section 29: E/2, SW/4

2. EOG has met with the New Mexico State Land Office and agreed upon the form of the Unit Agreement.

3. EOG is the designated operator under the Unit Agreement and the unitized interval includes all depths under the proposed Unit Area.


4. The Unit Agreement has been approved by a sufficient percentage of the interest owners within the proposed Unit Area to provide effective control of unit operations.

5. Approval of this Application is in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, EOG requests that this Application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on October 1, 2015, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order granting this Application.
