Application of Magnum Hunter Production, Inc. for Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from approximately 10,682 feet subsurface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the S/2 of Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit in the Morrow formation (South Empire-Morrow Gas Pool), which is developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent.
