CASE 13537 Application of Lance Oil & Gas Company, Inc. for compulsory pooling including optional infill well provisions, San Juan County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests to the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs formation and the Basin Fruitland Coal-Gas Pool underlying the following described acreage in Section 22, T29N, R13W, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico: (a) the W/2 of this section to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any production from the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool to be dedicated to its FRPC "22" Well No. 2 (API# 30-045-33160) to be drilled at a standard gas well location in the NW/4 and to its FRPC "22" Well No. 3 to be drilled at a standard gas well location in the SW/4; and (b) the NW/4 and the SW/4 to form two standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration units for any production from the Pictured Cliffs formation, including but not limited to the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool with the NW/4 dedicated to the FRPC "22" Well No. 2 and the SW/4 dedicated to the FRPC "22" Well No. 3 both for downhole commingled production from the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool and the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool. ### APPLICATION

Lance Oil & Gas Company, Inc. ("Lance") by its attorneys, Kellahin & Kellahin, and in accordance with Section 70-2-17.C NMSA (1978) seeks an order pooling all mineral interests to the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs formation and the Basin Fruitland Coal-Gas Pool underlying the following described acreage in Section 22, T29N, R13W, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico: (a) the W/2 of this section to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any production from the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool to be dedicated to its FRPC "22" Well No. 2 (API# 30-045-33160) to be drilled at a standard gas well location in the NW/4 and to its FRPC "22" Well No. 3 to be drilled at a standard gas well location in the SW/4; and (b) the NW/4 and the SW/4 to form two standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any production from the Pictured Cliffs formation, including but not limited to the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool with the NW/4 dedicated to the FRPC "22" Well No. 2 and the SW/4 dedicated to the FRPC "22" Well No. 3 both for downhole commingled production from the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool and the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool. The applicant also seeks to include provisions for subsequent operations and procedures for an optional "infill" coalbed-gas well. Also to be considered will be the costs of drilling and completing these wells and the allocation of the costs thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Lance Oil & Gas Company, Inc. as the operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in this well.

In support of its application, Lance Oil & Gas Company, Inc. ("Lance") states:

1.Effective October 1, 2004, Lance became the successor to Richardson Operating Company ("Richardson").

- 2. Lance has a working interest ownership in the oil and gas minerals from the surface to the base of the Pictured Cliffs formation underlying the NW/4, the SW/4 and the W/2 of Section 22, T29N, R13N, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- 3. These gas spacing units are located within the boundaries of the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool and the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool.
- 4. By letter dated, June 2, 2005, Lance proposed to the other working interest or mineral owners its FRPC "22" Well No. 2 be drilled and dually completed in the Pictured Cliffs and Fruitland coalbed formations to be dedicated to a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the W/2 and a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the NW/4 both in Section 22.
- 5. On June 17, 2005, the OCD-Aztec, approved an APD filed by Lance for its FRPC "22" Well No. 2 and assign API #30-045-33160.
- 6. By letters dated, July 13, 2005, Lance proposed to Synergy Operating, LLC both its FRPC "22" Well No. 2 (NW/4) and its FRPC "22" Well No. 3 (SW/4) be drilled and dually completed in the Pictured Cliffs and Fruitland coalbed formations to be dedicated to a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the W/2 and standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the NW/4 for the FRPC "22" Well No. 2 and the SW/4 for the FRPC "22" Well No. 3 all in Section 22.
- 7. After its well proposal letters, Lance learned that Synergy was "top leasing" interests held by Lance and in direct competition with Lance for the development of the W/2 of this section.
- 8. On July 20, 2005, after receiving Lance's well proposal letters, Synergy Operating LLC ("Synergy") applied for and received OCD approval for an APD for its well in the SW/4 of this section.
- 9. On July 13, 2005, Lance received a letter dated July 13, 2005 from Synergy Operating, LLC proposing wells that conflict with those being proposed by Lance for the W/2 of this section.

- 10. On July 20, 2005, seven days after sending its well proposal letter to Lance, Synergy filed its application for compulsory pooling of the W/2 of this section that is docketed as OCD Case 13539 and currently pending hearing on the August 11, 2005 docket.
- 11. On July 27, 2005, a representative of Lance met with Mr. Patrick Hegarty, a principal of Synergy, who declined to settle this matter.
- 12. Despite its reasonable efforts, Lance has been unable to obtain a written voluntary agreement from certain uncommitted working interest and/or mineral interest owners as shown on **Exhibit "A"** and has also been unable to reach a voluntary agreement with Synergy.
- 13. The applicant also seeks to include provisions for subsequent operations and procedures for an optional "infill" coalbed gas well. **See Exhibit** "B" attached.
- 14. Pursuant to Section 70-2-17.C NMSA (1978) and in order to obtain its just and equitable share of potential production underlying this spacing unit, Lance needs an order of the Division pooling the interest identified above in order to protect correlative rights and prevent waste.
- 15. Applicant, in the absence of timely objection, will present its evidence by affidavit as provided by Division Rule 1207.A(1) and request the 200% risk charge in accordance with Commission Order R-11992, effective August 15, 2003.
- 16. In accordance with the Division's notice requirements, a copy of this application has been sent to the parties whose interest is to be pooled as listed on Exhibit "A" notifying each of this case and of the applicant's request for a hearing of this matter before the Division on the next available Examiner's docket now scheduled for August 25, 2005.

WHEREFORE, Lance Oil & Gas Company, Inc, as applicant, requests that this application be set for hearing on August 25, 2005 before the Division's duly appointed examiner, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the mineral interest described in the appropriate spacing unit for these wells to be drilled at standard well locations upon terms and conditions which include:

- (1) Lance Oil & Gas Company, Inc. be named operator.
- (2) Provisions for applicant and all working interest owners to participate in the costs of drilling, completing, equipping and operating the well;
- (3) Provisions for subsequent operations and procedures for an optional "infill" coalbed gas well.
- (4) In the event a mineral interest or working interest owner fails to elect to participate, then provision be made to recover out of production, the costs of the drilling, completing, equipping and operating the well, including a risk factor penalty of 200%;
- (5) Provision for overhead rates per month drilling and per month operating and provision providing for an adjustment method of the overhead rates as provided by COPAS;

(6) For such other and further relief as may be proper.

Lance Oil & Gas Company Leases

- () Pursuant to Division Rule 104, an optional infill well may be drilled and produced within this 320-acre spacing unit or subsequent operations conducted for either the original well or the infill well in accordance with the following provisions:
  - (a) Lance Oil & Gas Company, Inc., or its successor, shall continue to be the operator of the parent well and the infill well;
  - (b) The operator or any working interest owner who consents to and has paid its share of costs of the original well, pursuant to either an voluntary agreement or a compulsory pooling order, may propose drilling of an infill well or subsequent operations of either the original well or the infill well by giving written notice of the proposed well to all working interest owners and all unleased mineral owners with the 320-acre pooled unit. Any such proposal shall specify the work to be performed, the location, proposed depth, objective formations and the estimated costs of the operation.
  - (c) The parties receiving such a notice shall have thirty (30) day election period after receipt of this notice within which to notify the proposing party whether they elect to participate in the costs of the subsequent operations or the infill well. Failure of a party receiving such notice to deliver to the proposing party an written election, plus payment for this share of the total costs, within a thirty (30) day election period shall constitute an election by that party not to participate in the costs of the well or the proposal operation and shall be "a non-consenting party."
  - (d) Any non-consenting party shall be subject to a 200% risk penalty charge for that well or the operations.
  - (e) Production from the original well cannot be used to pay for the costs of the infill well or can production from the infill well be used to pay for the costs of the original well. The recovery of costs for subsequent operations shall be paid by the production from the well on which those operations were conducted.
  - (f) If all parties elect to participate in the infill well or in subsequent operations ("a consenting party"), the operator shall, within ninety (90) days after the expiration of the thirty (30) day election period, actually commence and conduct operations with due diligence at the risk of expense of all parties.
  - (g) If less that all parties elect to participate in the infill well or the subsequent operations, then all parties who elected not to participate shall be considered non-consenting working interest owners and all the provisions of this order shall apply to the drilling of the infill well or the subsequent operations with the FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS:
    - a. The proposing party shall be solely responsible for carrying the no-consenting working interest owner's interest subject to the risk penalty charge provided for in the order. The proposing party may enter into an agreement, or



recognize an existing agreement, that provides for the sharing of the non-consenting interest by the consenting parties. The proposing party, at its election, may withdraw such proposal if there is insufficient participation and shall notify the Division and all other parties of such decision.

- b. If the operator is a non-consenting working interest owner in the infill well, the consenting parties shall either: (a) request the operator to perform the work required for the account of the consenting parties, or (b) designate one of the consenting parties as operator of the infill well. If the infill well results in a producer of oil and/or gas in paying quantities, one of the consenting parties shall be designated as operator and shall completed and equip the well to produce at the sole costs and risk of the consenting parties and thereafter the operator designated by this compulsory pooling order shall operator this well at the expense and for the account of the consenting working interest owners.
- c. To be entitled to the benefits of this order, the operator, or the designated consenting party, shall within ninety (90) days after the expiration of the thirty (30) day election period, actually commence and conduct the operations with due diligence at the sole risk and expense of the consenting parties.
- d. If operations for the drilling of an infill well results in a dry hole, the consenting parties shall plug and abandon the well and restore the surface location at their sole costs, risk and expense.
- () If operations for the drilling of a proposed infill well or any subsequent operation for either the original well or the infill well have not been commenced within the time provided, and if any party still desires to drill the infill well, written notice proposing same must be resubmitted in accordance with the provision hereof as if no prior proposal had been made
