SECOND AMENDED APPLICATION

Samson Resources Company ("Samson"), Kaiser-Francis Oil Company ("Kaiser-Francis"), and Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne"), for their application, state:

- 1. Samson, Kaiser-Francis, and Mewbourne are working interest owners in Lots 9, 10, 15, 16, and the SE¼ of irregular Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and have the right to drill a well thereon. The mineral interest under said acreage is owned entirely by the State of New Mexico: Lots 9, 10, 15, and 16 of Section 4 are subject to State Oil and Gas Lease V-7054; and the SE¼ of Section 4 is subject to State Oil and Gas Lease B-1481-14.
- 2. The working interests of Samson, Kaiser-Francis, and Mewbourne in Lots 9, 10, 15, 16, and the SE¼ of Section 4 are subject to an operating agreement among said parties covering all depths, and they agreed to drill the Osudo "4" State Com. Well No. 1, to be located 660 feet from the south line and 1650 feet from the east line of Section 4. Said acreage is to be dedicated to the well, forming a standard 320 acre gas spacing proration unit for all formations or pools developed on 320 acre spacing, including the South Osudo-Morrow Gas Pool. In addition, Mewbourne, Kaiser-Francis, and Samson have executed a communitization agreement for said acreage, as to all Pennsylvanian-age formations, and the agreement has been approved by the Commissioner of Public Lands.

- 3. On March 10, 2005, Chesapeake Operating, Inc. ("Chesapeake") filed with the Division's Hobbs District Office an Application for Permit to Drill ("APD") for the KF 4 State Well No. 1, to be drilled to test the Morrow formation. The APD was approved on March 11, 2005, and the S½ of Section 4 is allegedly dedicated to the well. Chesapeake owns no interest in the SE¼ of Section 4, which includes the drillsite for Chesapeake's proposed well. In addition, upon information and belief, Chesapeake owns no interest in the SW¼ of Section 4.
- 4. Chesapeake also filed with the Division's Hobbs District Office an APD for the proposed Cattleman 4 State Com. Well No. 1, to be drilled to test the Morrow formation. The APD was approved on or about March 21, 2005, and Lots 1, 2, 7-10, 15, and 16 of Section 4 are allegedly dedicated to the well. However, Chesapeake owns no interest in Lots 9, 10, 15, and 16 of Section 4, which includes the drillsite for said well. In addition, upon information and belief, Chesapeake owns no interest in Lots 1, 2, 7, and 8 of Section 4.
- 5. The foregoing APDs were obtained without the knowledge of, or without notice being given to, applicants.
- 6. On March 30, 2005, Mewbourne filed with the Division's Hobbs District Office an APD for the proposed Osudo "4" State Com.Well No. 1. The APD was returned to Mewbourne, unapproved, by the Hobbs District Office, apparently because of the approval of Chesapeake's APDs described above.
- 7. Samson, Kaiser-Francis, and Mewbourne have voluntarily committed 100% of the working interest in Lots 9, 10, 15, 16, and the SE¼ of Section 4 to the proposed Osudo "4" State Com. Well No. 1. A stand-up unit, as proposed, conforms to the Morrow geology and is necessary to protect correlative rights.

- 8. Samson, Kaiser-Francis, and Mewbourne should be allowed to form their proposed unit and drill their well. Mewbourne's APD should be approved.
- 9. The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

WHEREFORE, Samson, Kaiser-Francis, and Mewbourne request that, after notice and hearing, (i) Chesapeake's APDs be cancelled, (ii) a stand-up unit, as proposed by applicants, be approved, and (iii) the decision of the Hobbs District Office be reversed, and Mewbourne's APD be approved.
