I have previously entered my appearance on behalf of Kaiser-Francis Oil Company in Case No. 13492 and by separate letter, will also do so in Case No. 13493.

As you know, Kaiser-Francis Oil Company, Samson Resources Company and Mewbourne Oil Company have consolidated their interests under State of New Mexico Oil and Gas Lease No.s V-7054 (Lots 9, 10, 15 & 16) and B-1481-14 (SE/4) under that Communitization Agreement dated April 1, 2005 and approved by the Commissioner of Public Lands on April 27, 2005 covering the E/2 S/3 of Section 4 T21S, R35E forming a stand-up gas spacing and proration unit. This same acreage is also the subject of that Operating Agreement entered into by the parties dated March 25, 2005. By agreement of the parties, Samson Resources Company is now the designated operator under the Communitization Agreement and the Operating Agreement.

On approximately April 27, 2005, Chesapeake Operating, Inc. began drilling the KF "4" State Well No. 1 located 990' FEL and 660' FSL of Section 4.

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My client has requested me to inform the Division that (1) Kaiser-Francis will support the request for relief set forth in the Application in Case No. 13492 to rescind Chesapeake Operting's APD for the referenced well, and (2) Kaiser-Francis will also oppose the efforts of Chesapeake Permian to form a S/2 unit pursuant to its application for compulsory pooling in Case No. 13493.
