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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 9:36 a.m.: 2 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next cause before the 3 Commission is Case Number 13,532. It's the de novo hearing 4 continued from the January 12th Commission meeting. 5 the Application of J.W. Neal, Patricia Neal and the Claudia 6 7 Young Trust to rescind Division Order Number SWD-984 in Lubbock [sic] County, New Mexico. 8 Counsel Brooks, could you bring us up to speed in 9 this case? 10 MR. BROOKS: I think we should first call for 11 appearances, and then I will give you a report. 12 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. The appearances in this 13 case are -- ? 14 Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, 15 MR. BRUCE: representing Platinum Exploration, Inc. I'll have a short 16 17 statement that maybe I can make in front of Mr. Brooks statement, that will explain this. 18 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. 19 20 MR. BROOKS: That might be helpful. CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. Mr. Bruce, go ahead. 21 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Chairman, this involves a 22 23 saltwater disposal well. Platinum Exploration, Inc., applied for and received an administrative order approving 24 25 a saltwater disposal well in Section 18 of 17 South, 39

East. Subsequently Mr. Neal, et al., applied -- without going into it, they were -- into detail, the order was granted, and then a month or so after the administrative order was granted Mr. Neal, et al., applied to the Division to rescind the Division administrative order.

A hearing was held and the Hearing Examiner refused to rescind the Order, and Mr. Neal, et al., applied for a hearing de novo. The case was continued a couple of times.

Since the hearing, my client, Platinum

Exploration, Inc., has apparently conveyed these interests to another outfit out of Midland. I believe it's Saber Operating, LLC. I have notified my client that they should tell Saber, who is not my client, that they have this upcoming hearing, and I have never been in contact with Saber, and obviously they're not here today.

Last Friday or Monday, Mr. Brooks e-mailed Michael Comeau, who represented Mr. Neal, et al., and me, and said no prehearing statements were filed, and said that either the case would be continued or dismissed by the Commission if the matter -- if appropriate pleadings weren't filed with the Commission.

Again, my client no longer has an interest in it, and neither do I, and Mr. Comeau is not here. I have not spoken with him. But I just wanted to let you know what

was going on. I think at this time the Commission can do whatever it decides to do at Mr. Brooks' bidding.

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CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Mr. Brooks?

MR. BROOKS: Mr. Chairman, honorable

Commissioners, as Mr. Bruce stated, I sent an e-mail on

Monday, March -- I'm sorry, February the 6th, to Mr. Comeau

who was counsel of record for the Applicants in this case,

and to Mr. Bruce who was counsel of record for the

operator, advising them that no prehearing statement had

been filed and that unless a motion for continuance was -
or unless a continuance was requested, that the case would

be -- or that the case might be dismissed by the Commission

for want of prosecution.

I received no response. I want to enter my
e-mail into evidence as Commission Exhibit 1. And in case
the Commission is disposed, in view of the absence of any
filing or appearance or other communication with the
Commission, assuming the Commission is disposed to dismiss
the case, I have caused an order of dismissal to be
prepared by the Commission Secretary.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. Comments from the Commission?

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: It sounds like the Neals don't want to prosecute any more of this case, so...

MR. BROOKS: We have received no communication, 1 no response to my e-mail, and they've filed nothing, either 2 3 a prehearing statement or a motion for continuance. COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Then I move we dismiss it. 4 COMMISSIONER OLSON: Second. 5 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: All those in favor? 6 7 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. COMMISSIONER OLSON: Aye. 8 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Opposed? Let the record 9 reflect that the motion carries. 10 I have before me the order that Mr. Brooks 11 indicated that he prepared. At this time I will review the 12 order and then ask the other Commissioners to do the same. 13 Mr. Brooks, this order dismisses the case without 14 prejudice; is that correct? 15 MR. BROOKS: Yes, that is correct. 16 understanding that any -- There's no language to that 17 effect in the order, but it's my understanding that any 18 19 order of dismissal by the Commission is without prejudice, 20 and there is the usual sentence that the Commission reserves jurisdiction to enter such further orders as might 21 be necessary in the case. 22 23 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Commissioner Bailey, does that 24 order reflect the will of the Commission? 25 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, it does, and I move
