APPLICATION

Comes now Tenneco Oil Company, and applies to the Oil Conservation Division of New Mexico for an order pooling all mineral interests in the Dakota and Mesa Verde Formations underlying the E/2 of Section 2, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, for the formation of a proration and spacing unit for the said production and in support thereof would show the Commission:

1. Applicant is the owner of the right to drill and develop the E/2 of Section 2, Township 30 North, Range 9 West.

2. Applicant proposes to drill a well to test the Dakota formation and Mesa Verde formation with the possibility of completing the well as a dual completion.

3. In the event of a Dakota/Mesa Verde dual, the E/2 of the subject section will be dedicated to the well.

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4. Applicant has sought to obtain the cooperation of all parties.

5. In order to obtain their just and equitable share of the production underlying the above lands, Applicant needs an order pooling the mineral interest involved.

6. Those who have not consented to join in the drilling of the well, with their addresses, to the best of applicant's information and belief, are as follows:

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costs of drilling the subject well, completing and equipping it, costs of operation, including costs of supervision and a risk factor in the amount of 200% for the drilling of the well, for such other and further relief as may be proper.
