AMENDED APPLICATION

COMES NOW, CHAMA PETROLEUM COMPANY, by and through the undersigned counsel and, as provided by §70-2-17, New Mexico Statutes Annotated, 1978 Compilation, hereby makes amended application supplementing the original application filed herein on September 21, 1983, for an order pooling all of the mineral interests in all formations from the surface to the base of the Mississippian formation, including the Morrow, Strawn, Cisco Canyon, Bone Springs, Victorio Peak, Abo, Glorieta, Yeso, San Andres, and Grayberg formations in and under the N/2 of Section 8, T19S, R26E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show the Division:

1. The percentage of the working interest owned or represented by the applicant Chama Petroleum Company in and under those tracts within the N/2 of Section 8 upon which the applicant has the right to drill, are as follow: NE/4 NW/4 - 37.5%; N/2 NW/4 - 50%; NW/4 - 37.5%; N/2 - 56.76875%.

- 2. The applicant proposes to dedicate the above referenced pooled lands to a well to be drilled at a standard location in the N/2 of said Section 8.
- 3. With the exception of the interests of the applicant, interest owners who have not agreed to the pooling of their interests for the drilling of the proposed well are indicated, along with their respective ownership percentages, on Exhibit "A", attached.
- 4. Said pooling of interests and well completion will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.
- 5. In order to permit the applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, the mineral interests should be pooled, and applicant should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that this Amended Application be set for hearing before the Division's duly appointed examiner, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the lands, including provisions for applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well, and its costs of supervision while drilling, and after completion, including overhead charges, and imposing a risk factor for the risk assumed by the applicant in drilling, completing and equipping the well, and making such other and further provisions as may be proper in the premises.
