COG Operating LLC for an order (1) creating a 160-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 30, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed **SL East 30 Federal Com No. 2H Well**, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 19 to a standard bottom hole location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 30. The completed interval for this well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.
