APPLICATION

Anschutz Oil Company, LLC applies for an order (i) approving a 650.32 acre nonstandard oil spacing and proration unit in the Mancos formation (Gavilan-Mancos Pool) and Dakota formation (Gavilan Greenhorn-Graneros-Dakota Pool) comprised of Lots 1-4, S½N½, and S½ (All) of Section 1. Township 24 North, Range 2 West, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and (ii) pooling all interests in the Mancos formation and Dakota formation underlying Section 1, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is an interest owner in Section 1, and has the right to drill a well thereon.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its Schmitz Well No. 1, at an orthodox location 1708 feet from the south line and 949 feet from the east line of Section 1, to a depth sufficient to test the Dakota formation. Applicant seeks to dedicate all of Section 1 to the well to form a nonstandard 650.32 acre spacing and proration unit in the Gavilan-Mancos Pool and Gavilan Greenhorn-Graneros-Dakota Pool. Applicant further seeks to pool all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the well.

3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in Section 1 for the purposes set forth herein.
