- I. <u>Case No. 15417</u>: Application of COG Operating LLC for a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order (i) creating a 240-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) comprised of the W/2 SW/4 of Section 12 and the W/2 W/2 of Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., in Lea County, and (ii) pooling all mineral interests in the Avalon Shale portion of the Bone Spring formation underlying this acreage. The project area is to be dedicated to applicant's Sombrero Federal Com No. 4H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit M of Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 34 East to a bottom hole location in Unit L of Section 12, Township 24 South, Range 34 East. The completed interval for the well will remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by the Division's rules. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost, the designation of COG Operating LLC as the operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The proposed project area is located approximately two miles northeast of Ochoa, New Mexico.
