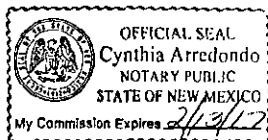

seeking an order ap-
proving a 160-acre
non-standard oil spac-
ing and proration unit
(project area) in the
Bone Spring formation
comprised of the
N/2N/2 of Section 25,
Township 24 South,
Range 28 East,
NMMPM. Applicant fur-
ther seeks the pooling
of all mineral interests
in the Bone Spring for-
mation underlying the
non-standard spacing
and proration unit
(project area) for all
pools or formations
developed on 40 acre
spacing within that
vertical extent. The
unit is to be dedicated
to the Paul 25-24S-
28E RB Well No. 121H,
a horizontal well with
a surface location in
