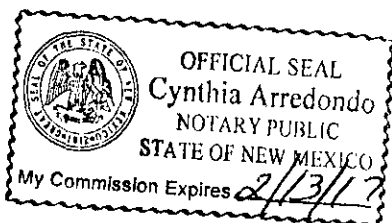

The unit will be dedicated to the Jimmy Kone 5-24S-28E RB Well No. 208H, a horizontal well with a surface location in the SW/4SW/4 of adjoining Section 4, and a terminus in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 5. Also to be considered will be the cost

of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, April 28, 2016 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interested owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date.
