APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

COG Operating LLC seeks to amend Order R-13808 to (1) pool additional uncommitted interest owners under the terms of Orders R-13535 and R-13535-A; and (2) pool the San Andrews formation within the Unit within the Penasco Draw-San Andres-Yeso (Associated) Pool (50270). Division Order R-13535, entered on April 11, 2012, created a 160-acre non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 31, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM in Eddy County, New Mexico, and pooled the mineral interests underlying said unit in the Penasco Draw-San Andres-Yeso (Associated) Pool (50270). Division Order R-13535-A was subsequently issued to pool additional mineral interests and to change the

initial well dedicated to the Unit to the **Falabella 31 Fee No. 8H Well** (API No. 30-015-39515). The **Falabella 31 Fee No. 8H Well** was drilled from a surface location 150 feet from the South line and 380 feet from the East line (Unit P) to a standard bottomhole location 330 feet from the North line and 380 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 31.

Since the entry of Orders R-13535 and 13535-A, certain leases have expired and a Joint Operating Agreement terminated, resulting in mineral interest owners that are no longer contractually committed to the well. COG now seeks to amend Orders R-13535 and 13535-A to include these additional interests under the terms of those pooling orders. COG also seeks to pool the San Andres formation within the Unit, in addition to the Yeso formation, within the Penasco Draw-San Andres-Yeso (Associated) Pool.


