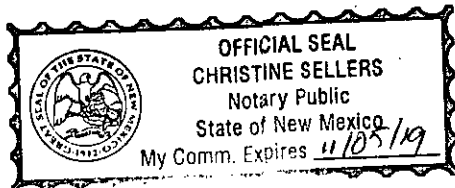

Applicant seeks approval of Ponderosa Unit consisting of 19,839 acre more or less, of Federal, State, and Indian Allotted lands situated in all or parts of Sections 5 of Township 23 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M. all or parts of Sections 1-14 and 17-20 of Township 23 North, Range 10 West, all or parts of Sections 1, Section 11-15, and Section 22-24 of Township 23 North, Range 11 West, N.M.P.M. all or parts of Section 31, Township 24 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M., and all of Section 3, Township 24 North, Range 11 West, N.M.P.M. San Juan County, New Mexico. The unitized interval is the stratigraphic equivalent of the interval described as the Mancos Shale Group, including the genetically related rocks from 10 feet below the stratigraphic equivalent of the top of the Mancos Shale (base of Mesa Verde Group) to the top of the stratigraphic equivalent of the base of the Greenhorn Limestone (top of the Graneros Shale) as shown in the Kinbeton G-Federal-1 well (API # 3004525087) well, Section 8, Township 23, North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., extending from 3,450' to 5,15' (measured depth). In addition, Applicant seeks an order creating a new pool for the unitized interval underlying the proposed Unit Area that will allow for 330 foot setbacks from the exterior of the proposed Unit. The subject acreage is located approximately 10 miles west of Nageezi, New Mexico.
