Application of Encana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc. To Amend Order Order R-14081 To Expand The North Alamito Unit And The Corresponding North Alamito Unit; Mancos Pool, Sandoval and San Juan Counties, New Mexico. Applicant seeks to amend Order R-14081 to (1) expand the geographic area of the North Alamito Unit by 1,282.40 of Federal and Fee land; and (2) expand the corresponding North Alamito Unit; Mancos Pool created by that Order to allow horizontal wells to be located anywhere within the Unit so long as the completed interval is no closer than 330 feet from the outer boundary of the expanded North Alamito Unit area. The proposed expanded Unit Area will consist of approximately 14,422.78 acres of Federal. Indian Allotted, State and Fee lands located in all or parts of the following sections in Sandoval and San Juan Counties, New Mexico: Sections 3-8 of T-22-N, R-7-W; Sections 1 and 12, T-22-N, R-8-W; Sections 19-23, 25-35, T-23-N, R-7-W; and Sections 25 and 36, T-23-N, R-8-W. The unitized interval is 100 feet below the stratigraphic equivalent of the top of the Mancos Shale (base of the Mesa Verde Group) to the stratigraphic equivalent of the Greenhorn Limestone as shown in the Lybrook H36-2307 01H Well (API No. 30-043-21117) in Section 36, Township 23 North, Range 7 West, N.M.P.M. The subject acreage is located approximately 1 mile south of Lybrook, New Mexico.
