COG's application seeks an order (i) approving a 240-acre non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 8 and the E/2 SW/4 of Section 5, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., in Lea County, and (ii) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this average. The proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for COG's King Air 8 Fed Com #3H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit C of Section 17, Township 19 South, Range 32 East to a bottom hole location in Unit K of Section 5, Township 19 South, Range 32 East. The completed interval for the well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.
