PRE-HEARING STATEMENT**

Rockcliff Operating New Mexico LLC ("Rockcliff") submits its Pre-Hearing Statement pursuant to the rules of the Oil Conservation Division.

Rockcliff is the applicant in this case. Its business address is 1301 McKinney Street, Suite 1300, Houston, Texas 77010. Rockcliff is represented by the undersigned counsel.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Rockcliff's application seeks an order (i) approving a 160-acre, non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 20, Township 8 South, Range 34 East, in Roosevelt County, and (ii) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the San Andres formation underlying this average. The proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the Annapurna 20 #1H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit P of Section 17, Township 8 South, Range 34 East to a bottom hole location in Unit P of Section 20, Township 8 South, Range 34 East. The completed interval for the well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.
