Case No. 15617: Application of CK Disposal, LLC for a Commercial Surface Waste Management Facility Permit in Lea County, New Mexico. CK Disposal, LLC has applied with the Oil Conservation Division for a permit to operate a surface oil field waste management facility pursuant to 19.15.36 NMAC. The proposed facility will be located within the North ½ of Section 5, Township 22 South, Range 38 East NMPM. The waste management facility is intended for the permanent disposal of exempt and non-exempt/non-hazardous oil field waste and will include a liquid waste processing area on 51.75 acres, a possible deep well water injection unit on 5.1 acres, and a landfill on 141.5 acres. The remaining 118.62 acres incorporates buffer areas, site structures, and access roads. The landfill will have a waste capacity of approximately 24.6 million cubic yards. The Director of the Oil Conservation Division is scheduling a hearing on the application pursuant to 19.15.36.10(A) NMAC and before the Oil Conservation Commission pursuant to 19.15.4.20 NMAC. The hearing shall be conducted in accordance with 19.15.4 NMAC.
