Dear Mr. Sexton:

During the course of conducting our environmental due diligence as part of the site suitability and analysis of the property located due south of the URENCO facility and due west of the Lea County Regional Landfill, we reviewed correspondence, data and permit conditions related to the URENCO USA Discharge Permit issued by the New Mexico Environmental Department (NMED).

It was discovered that uranium contamination has been found at a shallow depth in your monitoring wells. Given the fact that we are down gradient from your operation, we are gravely concerned about URENCO's contamination problem.

Up to this point, we have not yet pursued a discussion of our concerns over your uranium ground water contamination with NMED, NRC, EPA Region 6, City of Eunice, Lea County, local and state media outlets, the Sierra Club or the New Mexico Environmental Law Center.

I think it is best for us to speak immediately about these issues. I look forward to hearing from you upon receipt of this letter. If not, I will continue to pursue this matter through the abovementioned avenues.
