And so the materials that you would want to present
today, Mr Padilla, aren't reflected in an e-mail that
you sent to the State Land Office

MR PADILLA Counsel, we had one week essentially to hire an expert from August 6th to August 13th That took about three of those days And the only thing that we could submit by the 13th was an "outline" -- and that's not my word The word as I understood it was a "summary "

10 And I think that we've provided an adequate 11 content as to where we were coming from in response to 12 the land office case, and, particularly, trying to 13 address Examiner Goetze's question about how the upper San Andres and the lower San Andres are separated, 14 15 because he felt that correlative rights may be impaired 16 to the upper San Andres which is a producing interval in 17 the San Andrea zone or formation here

But going a bit further, the OCD has never had formal discovery of requirements where applicants or opponents, for that matter, submit formal reports as you would in expert witness disclosures in federal court or, maybe, by virtue of scheduling orders, in state district courts that have ordered And in those cases, we were given way more
