APPLICATION OF STEWARD ENERGY II, LLC FOR A NON-STANDARD SPACING AND PRORATION UNIT AND COMPULSORY POOLING, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Case No. 15670 (Re-opened)

SECOND AMENDED APPLICATION

Pursuant to NMSA § 70-2-17, Steward Energy II, LLC ("Steward") requests that the Division re-open this case and enter an order (i) approving a 480-acre, non-standard spacing and proration unit in the SW/4 of Section 3 and the W/2 of Section 10, Township 14 South, Range 38 East in Lea County, New Mexico, and (b) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the San Andres formation. In support of its Second Amended Application, Steward states:

- 1. Steward (OGRID No. 371682) is a working interest owner in the SW/4 of Section 3 and the W/2 of Section 10 and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Steward proposes to dedicate the above-referenced non-standard spacing and proration unit as the project area for the Pollo Hermanos State #5H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit N of Section 10 to a bottom hole location in Unit K of Section 3, Township 14 South, Range 38 East.
- 3. The completed interval for the Pollo Hermanos State #5H well will remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by 19.15.15.9(A) NMAC.
- 4. Steward has undertaken diligent, good-faith efforts to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners in the proposed project area to participate in the drilling of the well, but has been unable to obtain voluntary agreements from all of the mineral interest owners.

- 5. The pooling of those uncommitted mineral interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.
- 6. In order to allow Steward to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the non-standard spacing and proration unit should be pooled and Steward should be designated the operator of the proposed horizontal well and project area.

WHEREFORE, Steward requests that this Second Amended Application be set for hearing on August 17, 2017 and that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter an order:

- A. Approving a 480-acre, non-standard spacing and proration unit (project area) in the San Andres formation in the SW/4 of Section 3 and the W/2 of Section 10, Township 14 South, Range 38 East, in Lea County;
 - B. Pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the proposed project area;
- C. Designating Steward as the operator of the project area and the Pollo Hermanos State #5H well;
- D. Authorizing Steward to recover its costs of drilling, equipping, and completing the well;
- E. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the Pollo Harmanos State #5H well and allocating the cost among the uncommitted mineral interest owners;
- F. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision during drilling and after completion, together with a provision for adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and

G. Imposing a 200% penalty for the risk assumed by Steward in drilling and completing the Pollo Hermanos State #5H well against any mineral interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the well.
