OXY seeks an order (1) creating a 160-acre non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the N/2 S/2 of Section 29, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this acreage. OXY proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing and proration unit as the project area for its proposed **Cedar Canyon 29 Federal Com No. 24H Well,** which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section to a standard

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bottom hole location in NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 29. The completed interval for this well will remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by the Statewide Rules set forth in 19.15.15 NMAC.
