APPLICATION

Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. ("Devon"), in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste, applies for an order canceling or suspending twenty four (24) applications for permit to drill ("APD") issued to XTO Energy Inc. ("XTO") for wells located in all of Section 24 and the N/2 of Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

1. Devon is a working interest owner in the E/2 of Sections 22, all of Section 23, and all of Section 24, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., and has plans to drill a number of east-west horizontal wells in the Bone Spring and Wolfcamp formations on its acreage. The wells which Devon has planned are listed on Exhibit A.

2. The bulk of Devon's acreage is federal land, and is within the designated oil-potash area subject to Order No. 3324 issued by the Secretary of the Interior. Devon is the designated operator under existing operating agreements covering the E/2 of Section 22 and all of Section 23. This acreage cannot be developed by north-south horizontal wells due to potash restrictions. The filing of APDs for Devon's planned wells depends upon the creation of drilling islands and development areas that must be approved by the Bureau of Land Management ("BLM"), and thus will take additional time to complete.

3. XTO has obtained APD's for twenty four (24) north-south horizontal wells in the Bone Spring and Wolfcamp formations traversing all of Section 24 and the N/2 of Section 25. The wells are listed on Exhibit B. Devon believes that if XTO is permitted to drill its north-south horizontal wells as proposed, it will strand Devon's acreage in the E/2 of Section 22 and all of Section 23, and applies hereto for an order canceling or suspending the APD's listed on Exhibit B.

4. XTO's acreage is state land located within the oil-potash area designated by Secretarial Order No. 3324. Because it is state land, XTO has been able to obtain APDs in an expeditious manner and without regard to Secretarial Order No. 3324. In addition, XTO has recently staked easements for access to its wellsites.

5. XTO has filed non-standard unit and/or compulsory pooling applications on six (6) wells including portions of Section 24, which are currently set for hearing on the September 28th docket (Case Nos. 15382, 15384, 15386, 15838, 15840, and 15842). Devon owns working interests in these wells.

6. Secretarial Order No. 3324 pertains to "Oil, Gas and Potash Leasing and Development within the Designated Potash Area of Eddy and Lea Counties, New Mexico." This order is meant to allow oil and gas lessees and potash lessees to develop their mineral interests, and encourages cooperation among the various interest owners in a "Development Area" as defined in the order. The BLM is authorized to determine a Development Area and an associated Drilling Island as defined in Secretarial Order No. 3324.

7. Devon has previously met with and discussed on multiple occasions the issue of stranding acreage with XTO and the BLM, and in addition the BLM has consulted with the potash lessee on multiple occasions as to the potential location of drilling islands, so that all

acreage in the subject lands may be developed. The New Mexico State Land Office has also been made aware of this specific issue of stranded acreage. After continued communications with XTO about alternative surface locations, XTO has been inflexible in its plans for drilling north-south horizontal wells. A brief timeline of Devon's efforts in 2017 to develop its interests is set forth below:

(a) February 1: initial meeting with potash lessee and BLM for Section 24 drill island review.

(b) July 11: physical onsite visit of the proposed drill island, with attendees from Devon, XTO, BLM, Chevron, and COG.

(c) August 2: meeting at BLM office, with attendees from Devon, XTO, BLM, and State Land Office.

(d) August 24: phone conference between Devon and XTO land/reservoir personnel.

(e) September 6: phone conversation between Devon and XTO drilling personnel.

(f) Other email and phone communications between Devon, XTO, and BLM personnel not listed above.

8. XTO's APDs should be canceled or suspended for the following reasons:

(a) If XTO's wells are drilled, it will result in stranded leasehold acreage in the E/2 of Section 22 and all of Section 23 which cannot be drilled for oil and gas production therefor causing waste of natural resources;

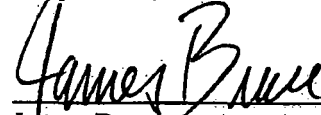
(b) XTO's plans do not comply with Secretarial Order No. 3324's intent for cooperative development between operators in the oil-potash area;

(c) Until a development plan can be agreed upon or fixed by appropriate governmental authority, the drilling of any of XTO's planned wells is premature and will result in the impairment of correlative rights of interest owners in the E/2 of Section 22 and all of Section 23.

9. The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order canceling or suspending the APDs for the XTO wells listed on Exhibit B, and granting such further relief as the Division deems proper to prevent the stranding of oil and gas leasehold acreage.

Application of Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. for cancelation or suspension of applications for permit to drill issued to XTO Energy Inc., Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order canceling or suspending twenty four (24) applications for permit to drill issued to XTO Energy Inc. for proposed horizontal Bone Spring and Wolfcamp wells located in Section 24 and the N½ of Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M. The proposed wells are located approximately 4-1/2 miles northeast of Harroun, New Mexico.

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
