STATEMENT OF THE CASE

COG's application seeks an order (i) approving a 343.26-acre, more or less, non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of Lots 2, 3, and 4 in Section 19, Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 in Section 30, and Lots 1 and 2 in Section 31, Township 26 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., in Eddy County, and (ii) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying this acreage. The proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the Copperhead 31 Fee #20H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Lot 2 of Section 31 to a bottom hole location in Lot 2 of Section 19, Township 26 South, Range 29 East. The completed interval for the well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.
