Subject: XTO/Devon

All: As I have informed Jordan, Devon has been able to work with the BLM to obtain a new drilling island which will allow Devon to develop its acreage in Sections 22 and 23 with north-south horizontals. This means Devon does not object to XTO's development of Sections 24, 25, and 36 with north-south horizontals. As a result, Devon will not be pursuing its application in Case 15864 (cancelation of APDs). Therefore, XTO's cases will not be contested, and the hearing time will be reduced from one day down to whatever time it takes XTO to present its paperwork. Devon will present 5-10 minutes of testimony on one issue only: Because XTO seeks to force pool 24 wells at one time, Devon would like to have a sequencing of well elections, rather than making 24 elections all at once. Devon will continue to work with XTO on this issue.
