



Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order (1) creating a 320.87-acre, more or less, non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 2 and the E/2 W/2 of Section 11, Township 25 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit. 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
