STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order approving a 240-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the S/2NW/4 of Section 29 and the S/2N/2 of Section 30, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard unit. The unit will be dedicated to the Pavo Frio 29/30 B2FE Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a surface location in the SW/4NE/4 of Section 29, and a terminus in the SW/4NW/4 of Section 30. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for

supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
