This proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the Ender Wiggins Federal 25- 34-14 WA 1H well, to be horizontally drilled. The producing area for the well will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Marathon as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well.
