APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

Applicant filed administrative applications with the Division on May 29, 2018 for orders authorizing injection of produced water for disposal purposes in four proposed wells at the following updated locations:

- 1. Bear Trap SWD No. 1, with a surface location, 320 feet from the South line and 2547 feet from the East line of Section 34, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, a maximum proposed daily injection rate of approximately 25,000 barrels per day within the Devonian formation at a depth of approximately 13,280 feet to 14,280 feet deep, and a maximum injection pressure of 2,656 psi;
- 2. Giant Panda SWD No. 1, with a surface location, 1429 feet from the South line and 204 feet from the West line of Section 16, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, with a maximum proposed daily injection rate of approximately 25,000 barrels per day within the Devonian formation at a depth of approximately 13,255 feet to 14,255 feet deep, and a maximum injection pressure of 2,651 psi;

- 3. **Grizzly SWD No. 1**, with a surface location, 205 feet from the South line and 765 feet from the West line of Section 11, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, with a maximum proposed daily injection rate of approximately 25,000 barrels per day within the Devonian formation at a depth of approximately 13,420 feet to 14,420 feet deep, and a maximum injection pressure of 2,684 psi; and
- 4. Kodiak SWD No. 1, with a surface location, 210 feet from the South line and 2335 feet from the West line of Section 5, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, a maximum proposed daily injection rate of approximately 25,000 barrels per day within the Devonian formation at a depth of approximately 13,095 feet to 14,095 feet deep, and a maximum injection pressure of 2,792 psi.

The State Land Office has approved these updated locations.

Foundation Minerals, LLC, Mavros Minerals, LLC, Oak Valley Mineral and Land, L.P., and Delaware Operating – NM, LLC oppose the applications because they have plans to drill a competing salt water disposal well in offsetting acreage. Applicant Delaware Energy has protested that administrative application.

Delaware requests that its C-108 applications, filed first in time, be granted.
