ORDER ON EXTENSION OF STAY

This matter having come before the Oil Conservation Commission ("Commission") on the Third Status Report and Agreed Motion To Extend Stay ("Motion") filed by Permian Water Solutions, LLC ("Permian"). The Motion requests an extension of the stay for three months. Mewbourne Oil Company, Oxy USA, Inc. and Kaiser-Francis Oil Company do not oppose the request to extend the stay. The Chair, having considered the Motion, enters the following Order.

- 1. The Motion is granted. The stay of the proceedings before the Commission will be continued and no hearing will be scheduled.
- 2. The stay will be continued for an additional three months. If the case is not dismissed prior to January 30, 2019, the parties shall submit a status report to the Commission by that date and may request a further extension of the stay. Failure to submit a report or a request for an extension will result in the Commission scheduling this case for hearing.
