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APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

In Case No. 16435, Matador Production Company seeks an order (1) creating, if necessary, a 160-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 35, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation. The spacing unit will be dedicated to the proposed **Brad Dyer Federal No. 202H Well**, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 35. The completed interval for this well will remain within the standard offset required by the statewide rules set forth in 19.15.15 NMAC.

In Case No. 16407, Matador Production Company seeks an (1) creating, if necessary, a 160-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Section 35, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation. The spacing unit will be dedicated to the proposed **Brad Dyer Federal No. 205H Well**, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 35. The completed interval for this well will remain within the standard offset required by the statewide rules set forth in 19.15.15 NMAC.
