STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Lime Rock's application seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Yeso formation in a standard 160-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 N/2 of Section 13, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, in Eddy County. Lime Rock proposes to dedicate the horizontal spacing unit to the Leavitt 13 #1H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Lot 1 in Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 27 East to a last take point in Unit O in Section 13, Township 18 South, Range 26 East.


