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

The State of New Mexico, through its Oil Conservation Division, hereby gives notice that the Division will conduct a public hearing at 8:15 a.m. on May 17, 2018, to consider this application. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the standard 320-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 of Section 29, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. This proposed standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the Zeus Fee 23 28 29 WXY 12H, Zeus Fee 23 28 29 WXY 17H, Zeus Fee 23 28 29 WD 16H wells, to be horizontally drilled. The producing area for these wells will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said wells, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Marathon as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said wells.
