Charles Crosby, being duly sworn upon his oath, deposes and states:

1. I am over the age of 18, and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein.
2. I am a geologist for Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne"), and I am familiar with the geological matters involved in this case. I have been qualified by the Division as an expert petroleum geologist.
3. The following geological plats are attached hereto:
  - (a) Attachment A is a structure map of the Base of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Bone Spring Sand formation. It shows that structure dips consistently to the south. It also shows a line of cross-section.
  - (b) Attachment B is a gross sand isopach of the Lower 2<sup>nd</sup> Bone Spring Sand, the test zone for the proposed Loco Hills 1-2 B2AB Fed Com. Well No. 1H. It shows that the sand across the well unit has a uniform thickness of approximately 180 feet.
  - (c) Attachment C is a west-east cross section. The well logs on the cross-section give a representative sample of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Bone Spring Sand formation in this area. The target zone for the well is the Lower 2<sup>nd</sup> BSPG Sand, and that zone is continuous across the well unit.
4. I conclude from the maps that:
  - (a) The horizontal spacing unit is justified from a geologic standpoint.
  - (b) Each quarter-quarter section in the unit will contribute more or less equally to production.
  - (c) There is no faulting or other geologic impediment on the area which will affect the drilling of the subject well.
