APPLICATION OF CHISHOLM ENERGY OPERATING, LLC TO RE-OPEN CASE NO. 14940 TO POOL ADDITIONAL MINERAL OWNERS UNDER THE TERMS OF COMPULSORY POOLING ORDER NO. R-13691, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

## APPLICATION

Chisholm Energy Operating, LLC ("Chisholm") (OGRID No. 327137), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby applies to the Oil Conservation Division to pool the interests of additional mineral owners under the terms of Division Order No. R-13691. In support of this application, Chisholm states:

- 1. Division Order No. R-13691, entered on April 8, 2013, created a 160-acre spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring formation (South Lea-Bone Spring Pool (37580)) underlying of the E/2 W/2 of Section 23, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (the "Unit"). The Unit is dedicated to the Laguna 23 Federal Com Well No. 1H (API No. 30-025-40742), a horizontal well that has been drilled from a surface location 330 feet from the south line and 1,980 feet from the west line (Unit N) to a bottom hole location 335 feet from the north line and 1,938 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 23.
- 2. On June 7, 2017, Chisholm became operator of the Laguna 23 Federal Com Well No. 1H, as reflected on the Form C-145 on file at the Division.
- 3. Since taking over operations of this well, Chisholm has discovered additional mineral owners in the Unit, who were not provided notice of the June 7, 2012 compulsory pooling

hearing in Case No. 14940, and as a result, whose interests were not pooled by the terms of Order No. R-13691.

4. In order to provide proper notice to these additional mineral owners and to bring their interests under the terms of Order No. R-13691, Chisholm requests that Case No. 14940 be re-opened and called for hearing at the next available examiner docket.

WHEREFORE, Chisholm Energy Operating, LLC requests Case No. 14940 be re-opened and that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on June 13, 2019, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division pool the remaining uncommitted mineral owners in the Unit pursuant to the terms of existing Division Order No. R-13691.
