The Lone Mesa Unit Agreement, San Juan County, New Mexico is approved November 29, 2018 and is effective November 29, 2018. This agreement has been assigned case recordation number NMNM138623X. The basic information associated with this unit is as follows:

- 1. This is an Undivided Unit and only the Fruitland Formation is unitized.
- 2. This unit includes Federal, State and Indian allotted minerals.
- 3. The leases committed to the Lone Mesa Unit will not be horizontally segregated.
- 4. The Lone Mesa Unit #001H, API # 30-045-35895 is the initial obligation well. The surface hole location is located in the NW/4 SE/4, Section 28, T.22 N., R.8 W., San Juan County, New Mexico.
- 5. The following Federal leases contain lands both inside and outside the Lone Mesa Unit and are subject to segregation provisions pursuant to 43 CFR 3107.3-2, Segregation of leases committed in part:
 - a. *NMNM 122639

Expires May 31, 2019

b. *NMNM 137897

Extended

The Lone Mesa Unit embraces 5,445.18 acres more or less. The following three (3) tracts are unleased:

- a. Tract 21, with 160.00 acres, located in the NW/4, Section 29, T.22 N., R.8 W.,
- b. Tract 22, with 160.00 acres, located in the NE/4, Section 30, T.22 N., R.8 W.,
- c. Tract 23, with 160.00 acres, located in the SW/4, Section 25, T.22 N., R.9 W.

In view of the foregoing commitment status, effective control of the unit area has been established. We are of the opinion that this agreement is in the public interest and for the purpose of more properly conserving natural resources.

In accordance with Article 9 of the Lone Mesa Unit Agreement, the Lone Mesa Unit #001H well, API #30-045-35895 is the initial obligation well.

Pursuant to the subsequent drilling obligations of Section 10 of the unit agreement, a Plan of Development is required to be filed yearly.

Approval of this agreement does not warrant or certify that the operator thereof and other holders of operating rights hold legal or equitable title to those rights in the subject leases which are committed hereto.

CERTIFICATE-DETERMINATION
