We have determined that the Nash Unit No. 46H and 47H wells are capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities. The wells were completed in the Delaware Formation on August 20, 2017 and August 24, 2017, respectively. Consequently, an application for a sixth revision (effective date of August 1, 2017) to the Delaware Formation Participating Area shall be filed with the Reservoir Management Group pursuant to Section 11 of the unit agreement by December 31, 2018.
