Reference is made to your request dated November 1, 1991, to increase the surface injection pressure on 6 wells within the Lovington San Andres Unit Waterflood Project. This request is based on step rate tests conducted on these wells during July, 1991. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following
