Dear Mr. Duncan:

Reference is made to your request dated February 4, 1991, to increase the surface injection pressure on 3 wells within the Central Vacuum Unit Pressure Maintenance Project. This request is based on step rate tests conducted on these wells January 28-30, 1992. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells.


