(Off the record at 10:05 a.m.) 3 (The following proceedings had at 10:36 a.m.) CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Let's go back on the record. 5 This is the continuation of Causes Number 13,367, 13,368 6 and 13,372 at the Thursday, June 15th, 2006, regularly 7 8 scheduled meeting of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. Let the record reflect that the Commission is 9 coming out of executive session at this time. We have been 10 in executive for the last approximately 35 minutes, during 11 which case -- during which time, the only discussions that 12 were had concerned Cases Number 13,367, 13,368 and 13,372. 13 The Commission has reached a decision and has 14 directed counsel Bada to draft an order reflecting that 15 16 decision.
