In accordance with Section 10 of the Poker Lake Unit Agreement dated March 18, 1952, Bass Enterprises Production Co., Operator of the referenced unit, hereby submits a Plan of Development for the Poker Lake Unit for the year 2006.

HISTORY OF PAST DEVELOPMENT

We refer to our previous Plans of Development for a detailed description of the operations conducted in this Unit in prior years.

2005 ACTIVITY

<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 164, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> – This well was drilled at a location being 1,980' FSL & 1,980' FWL, Section 6, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Delaware Formation as an oil well in the interval between 7,060' – 7,354'.

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<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 212, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> – This well was drilled at a location being 660' FEL & 1,980' FEL, Section 18, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Delaware Formation as oil well in the interval between 7,050' – 7,371' to test the Delaware Formation.

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<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 217, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> – This well was drilled at a location being SENE, 1,680' FSL & 660' FEL, Section 19, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico.
