On September 18, 2001 the San Juan 30-6 Unit initial expansion through the twelfth expansion for the Dakota formation was submitted to our office for approval. The approval for these expansions was accomplished on January 8, 2003. The submission of these expansions caused a number of communitization agreements (CA) to become obsolete due to the inclusion into the Dakota participating area.

These agreements communitized particular acres of Federal, State, and fee lands within the San Juan 30-6 Unit as to natural gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons producible for the Dakota formation. The term of the agreement was for 2 years and for so long thereafter as communitized substances are produced in paying quantities.

Our records indicate that the wells dedicated to the described agreements were completed and that the public interest requirement for the communitization agreements, pursuant to 43 CFR 3105.2-3, have been met.

The effective termination date of these CA's is January 8, 2003, the date of approval for the Dakota formation expansions. All subject Federal leases involved with these CA's are **eligible** for a 2 year extension from the effective date of termination of the CA. All indicated wells will report to NMNM 78420D (Dakota participating area for San Juan 30-6 Unit) from effective termination date of CAs.


