Dear Mr. Pierce:

This office is in receipt of your letter of October 21, 2004 requesting our ratification to the South Redlake II Unit Agreement. We regret to inform you that the Commissioner of Public Lands cannot ratify the South Redlake II Unit Agreement. Please comply with State Land Office Rule 19.2.100.51 a copy of which has been enclosed.

When re-submitting your agreement for preliminary approval please submit the following:

- 1. A formal application letter requesting preliminary approval by the Commissioner of Public Lands.
- 2. The initial form of the Unit Agreement. The unit agreement form submitted is outdated and is not acceptable. Enclosed is a copy of our latest State, Federal and Fee Waterflood Unit agreement form. Updated copies of our unit agreement forms and rules and regulations can also be downloaded from our web site at http://www.nmstatelands.org.
- 3. Please submit an engineering report and geological data justifying the Unit boundaries. Also, please submit the worksheets and calculations used to determine the basis for allocation of unitized substances.
- 4. Pursuant to State Land Office Rule Number 19.2.100.51 the Commissioner of Public Lands discourages the use of fresh water in waterflood units in cases where salt water is practical. If an operator plans to use fresh water in a proposed unit, the following specific information should be provided:
 - a) Laboratory analyses of water compatibility tests (Fresh vs. Salt Water).
 - b) Reservoir analyses for swelling clays and soluble salts.
 - I. Estimate of monthly make-up water required for operations.
 - c) Location and depth of area salt water wells or quantities of produced water available for injection.
- 5. Updated copies of Exhibits "A" and "B" and "C".
- 6. A copy of the Unit Operating Agreement.
- 7. A copy of your Initial Plan of Operation.

- 8. A re-designation of well names and numbers.
- 9. The filing fee for a unit agreement is \$30.00 dollars for every section of partial section thereof. Please submit a \$120.00 filing fee.
- 10. On Exhibit "B", Tract Numbers 11 and 12, the correct Lessee of Record for State Lease No. B-11538-14 is ConocoPhillips and Atofina Petrochemical, Inc.
- 11. Please explain the commitment status of Tract No. 5. Will the tract participation in Tract No. 5 change after statutory unitization?
- 12. McQuadrangle, LC does not have a surface improvement damage bond filed with this office. Pursuant to State Land Office Rule 19.2.100.23 please submit a \$20,000 surface improvement damage bond to this office.
- 13. Please submit all ratifications from the Lessees of Record and Working Interest Owners. All signatures should be acknowledged by a notary and one set must contain <u>original</u> signatures.
- 14. Section 24, Effective Date and Term of the South Redlake II Unit Agreement, states that "if this agreement does not become effective on or before August 31, 2003, it shall ipso facto expire on said date (hereinafter called expiration date)." As of this date the Commissioner of Public Lands has not approved this agreement. This agreement expired by its own terms on August 31, 2003.
- 15. Please submit a copy of the NMOCD and BLM's approvals of this agreement to this office.


