CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next cause before the Commission is Case Number 13,586, the Application of the New Mexico Oil Division for repeal of existing Rules 709, 710, 711 concerning surface waste management and the adoption of new rules governing surface waste management.

This case has been continued to the April 20th, 2006, Commission meeting at the request -- at the motion, I believe, of an industry committee consisting of 17 operators in the state. That motion for continuance has been adopted, and this case will be continued to the April 20th, 2006, Commission meeting.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next cause before the Commission is Case Number 13,274, the Application of Arch Petroleum, Inc., for approval of two nonstandard gas spacing and proration units in the Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

I believe at the request of the Applicant this case has been committed -- "committed" -- continued, from the February 9th docket to the April 20th, 2006, Commission docket.

Enterprises Production Company for an order authorizing the

drilling of a well in the potash area in Eddy County, New

Mexico.

There's a related case, Case Number 13,368, the Application of Devon Energy Production Company, LP, for an order authorizing the drilling of a well in the potash area in Eddy County, New Mexico.

These cases will be continued to a special meeting.

At this time, Mr. Carr, who is -- I guess will make his appearance in both cases?

MR. CARR: Actually, Mr. Chairman, in all three cases. The last case is also a related case seeking well location in the potash area.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay, that's Case Number

13,372? And you're asking that these cases be specially
set together --

MR. CARR: Yes, sir.

The cases were heard over a year ago. And after the order was entered Mosaic Potash, who had opposed the case, sought hearing de novo.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: A full day for all three of them?

MR. CARR: For all three of them.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay.

MR. CARR: And we've asked for a special hearing date because of that, because every regular date has other things on it.

I have talked with Charles High, the attorney from Mosaic -- I talked with him several weeks ago and again yesterday afternoon -- and he has recommended three dates that he could be available to hear these. He has two cases going in federal court the next two months, so his schedule is unusually tight during this period of time, and he isn't available on either the 20th of April or the 18th of May.

But he would be available April the 12th or May

11th or 12th, and those are the days he asked me to suggest

to the Commission as possible hearing dates.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. Mr. Carr, I think the Commission should take that under --
