Re: *Administrative application (administrative application reference No. pKRV0-315428161) for an exception to Division Rule 104.B (1), revised by Division Order No. R-11231, issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 12119 on August 12, 1999, for Marbob Energy Corporation's proposed Zarafa "FF" Federal Well No. 2 at an unorthodox gas well location 1650 feet from the South line and 2550 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Undesignated Southeast Cemetery-Morrow Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, within a standard 320-acre stand-up gas spacing unit comprising the W/2 of Section 12.*

Dear Mr. Chumbley:

I have reviewed the subject application and the records of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") concerning this matter, please be advised that:

- (1) with the inception of Division Order No. R-11231, issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 12119 on August 12, 1999, enacted under Section 70-2-11, NMSA 1978, of the Oil and Gas Act ("Act"), which serves to protect correlative rights while simultaneously promoting the orderly development of oil and gas resources, operators have been given greater flexibility in locating deep gas wells thereby allowing an operator to drill at an optimal location within a 320-acre unit while avoiding surface obstructions; and
- (2) from the information provided, or lack thereof, there appear to be vast areas within the 320-acre unit not affected by "topographical issues" and that adequately meet the perimeters necessary for drilling at a standard deep gas well location within the W/2 of Section 12.

Under Division Rule 104.F (2) your application is neither justified nor warranted; therefore, this application is hereby **denied**.

As a reminder our pool rules are serious matters for the purpose of orderly development of New Mexico's valuable oil and gas resources. It is very easy to get into a mode of thinking that considers these rules as minor inconveniences and applications for exceptions as "open and shut" issues. Since the primary objective of the recent amendments to the location requirements for deep gas wells in southeast New Mexico (see the record in Case No. 12119) were to grant operators increased flexibility in locating wells and to decrease the number of applications for unorthodox locations, all future location exceptions will require substantial justification, i.e., unusual circumstances. Also, please refer to the findings in Division Order No. R-11364, issued in Case No. 12370 and dated April 28, 2000 (see copy attached) that addressed this issue further.



Mary Jo Rugwell, being first duly sworn on oath, states as follows:


1. My name is Mary Jo Rugwell. I reside in Carlsbad, New Mexico. I am the Assistant Field Manager for Land and Minerals in the Carlsbad Field Office of the Bureau of Land Management ("BLM"). My duties include oversight of this office's Surface Specialists.
2. BLM Surface Specialists meet with oil and gas operators and review proposed well locations to examine archeological, biological, topographical, cave karst, drainage and other considerations to determine the suitability of proposed well locations and make recommendations to this office on the general suitability of a proposed location based on these site specific conditions.
3. Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico is federal land administered by the Bureau of Land Management. Marbob Energy Corporation ("Marbob") owns operating rights in Federal Oil and Gas Lease No. NM 101077 that includes all of Section 12, and Marbob therefore has the right to explore for and develop the oil and gas minerals located under this acreage.
4. Marbob proposed to drill its Zarafa "FF" Federal Well No. 2 at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the North and West line of said Section 12 to test the Morrow formation, Undesignated Southeast Cemetery-Morrow Gas Pool.
5. In June 2003, Barry Hunt, BLM Surface Specialist, and Dean Chumbley, of Marbob Energy Corporation, made an on-site inspection of the location proposed by Marbob for the Zarafa "FF" Federal Well No. 2.
6. Based on this inspection Mr. Hunt recommended that the original Marbob location be moved and recommended two locations that met BLM surface resources concerns. Marbob advised the BLM that, due to geological considerations, these were not viable locations and proposed an alternative unorthodox well location 1650 feet from the South line and 2550 feet from the West line of said Section 12.

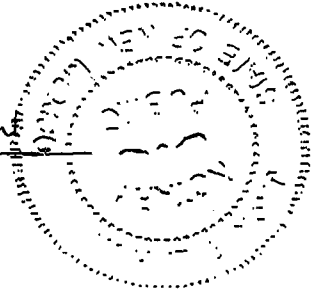
7. The well location proposed by Marbob Energy Corporation for the Zarafa "F?" Federal Well No. 2 at a point 1650 feet from the South line and 2550 feet from the West line of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, meets BLM surface resources concerns and the BLM has approved Marbob's Application for Permit to Drill the well at this location.



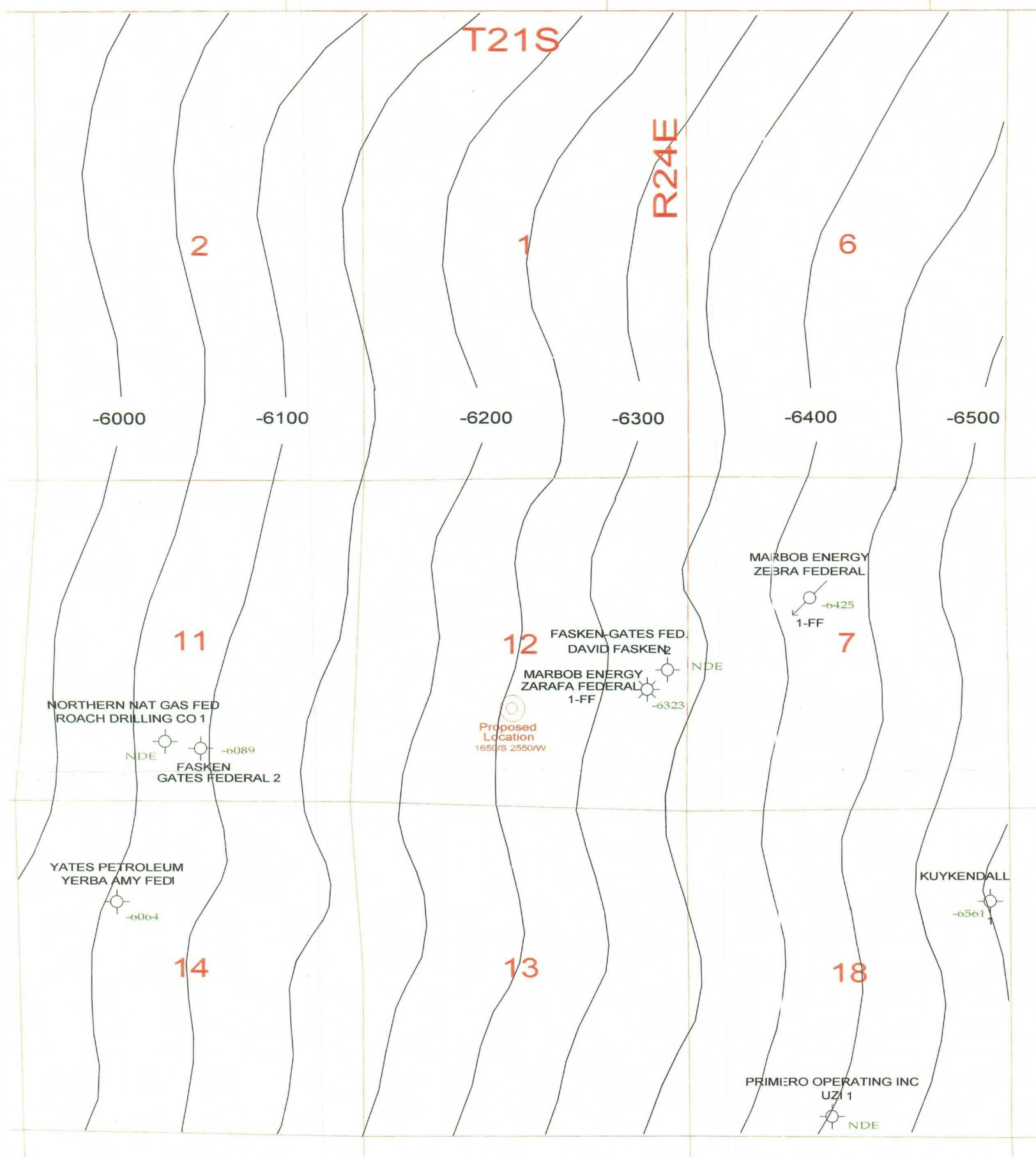

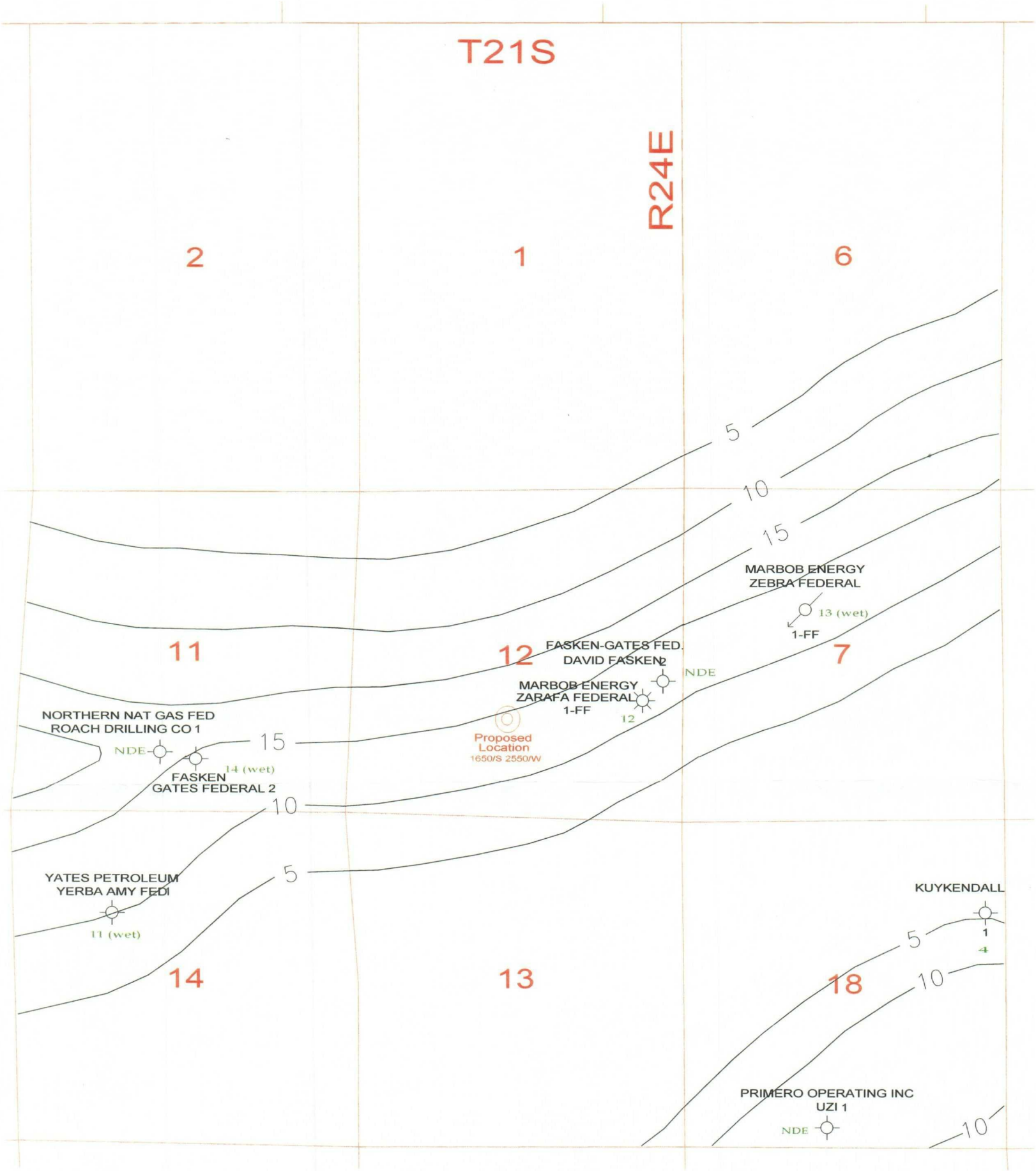
