(interest owner excluded from non-standard well unit): Unit Petroleum Company has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (Case No. 13780) seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the base of the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the N/2 of Section 17, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, and in the following manner: The N/2 to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 320 acre spacing within that vertical extent; the N/2 to form a non-standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit in the North Osudo-Morrow Gas Pool; the NE/4 to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 160 acre spacing within that vertical extent; and the NE/4NE/4 to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to the Monument 17 Well No. 1, to be drilled in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 17. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well, as well as approval of the non-standard unit. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, September 14, 2006 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit, or being excluded from the well unit, you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The well units are located approximately 6 miles southwest of Monument, New Mexico.
