

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the S/2 of Section 9, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, and a non-standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit in the Undesignated North Osudo-Morrow Gas Pool. The unit is to be dedicated to the Monument 9 Fed. Well No. 1, to be drilled in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 9. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as
